2016-2017 FINANCIAL INFORMATION FOR NON- UGANDAN STUDENTS COMING TO STUDY AT ABU-UGANDA

First Semester

The Grand Total amount of fees that the Malawian Students need to bring with them for 1st Semester is approx.

= **3,821,000 Ugandan shillings (Approx. \$1,100)**

and the breakdown is as follows at the estimated exchange rate of 1\$:UGX3,500

Tuition

- 1,209,000 Uganda Shillings (approx. \$346)

Other fees

- Accommodation 469,000 Ugandan shillings (approx. \$134)
- Meals - full board 667,000 Ugandan shillings (approx. \$191)
- Development fee 220,000 Ugandan shillings (approx. \$63)
- Books approx. 300,000 Ugandan shillings (approx. \$86)
- ID card 25,000 Uganda shillings (approx. \$8)
- Caution fee 50,000 Uganda shillings (approx. \$15)
(This is paid in first year, first semester only to cater for any property damage. Any balance will be refunded at graduation.)
- Health insurance 450,000 Ugandan shillings (approx. \$129) (This health insurance coverage which is mandatory for each student is for 12 months with International Hospital of Kampala)
- NCHE registration 20,000 Ugandan shillings (approx. \$6) (This is an annual registration fee levied by Uganda's National Council for Higher Education registration fee)
- International student visa \$100
(This is an annual student immigration Visa fee and is payable in September 2016)
- Student Visa processing charges: 20,000 Uganda Shillings (approx. \$6)

Note:

Some of these charges like Health Insurance, NCHE registration and International student visa are only paid once in a year and will not be asked for again during the 2nd semester.

Second Semester

The Grand Total amount of fees that the Malawian Students need to bring with them for 2nd Semester is approx.

= **2,870,000 Ugandan shillings** (Approx. \$820)

and the breakdown is as follows at the estimated exchange rate of 1\$:UGX3,500

Tuition

- 1,209,000 Uganda Shillings (approx. \$346)

Other fees

- Accommodation 469,000 Ugandan shillings (approx. \$134)
- Meals - full board 667,000 Ugandan shillings (approx. \$191)
- Development fee 220,000 Ugandan shillings (approx. \$63)
- Books approx. 300,000 Ugandan shillings (approx. \$86)

NOTE:

Fees are payable in Ugandan shillings so if the exchange rate goes up or down the dollar amount will change accordingly.

❖ EASTER BREAK:

There is an Easter Break of 10 days and students are expected during this period to return back to their homes to celebrate Easter. If they choose to stay on Campus, they will be charged around 10,000 Ugandan Shillings (approx. \$4) per day.

❖ DATE OF OPENING:

First year students: Orientation begins on Monday 28th August, 2017. Registration is in the morning and the orientation programme begins after lunch. If they arrive on Saturday or Sunday 26th- 27th August, there will be no extra charge.

Returning (2nd, 3rd & 4th year) students: All continuing students should return on Wednesday 30th August 2017. Registration will be in the afternoon of this return date from 1:30pm – 6:00 pm.
